Lodging options: The following list is but a few of the options available in the Vilcabamba area. There are many others. Please book directly with the facility of your choice.

On- site at our place! We have a few options here at the center available only to conference attendees.

Main lodge: East wing suite. This is a very artistic, very magical accommodation. A one of a kind suite, it is without a doubt one of the best rooms in all of Vilcabamba. It has a private terrace with great views of the entire valley of longevity where you can enjoy your breakfast or a glass of wine in the evening as well as a separate, private yoga/meditation area. The large bathroom with stone shower is a work of art in itself with amazing attention to detail. Price: \$80.00 / per night, double occupancy, breakfast included.

The Butterfly house: An enchanting fairytale type stone cottage. The funky, brightly colored interior consists of bedroom with queen size bed, a loft with full size bed, living / dining room, kitchen and bathroom with wonderful artistic stone shower. The house sits in a wonderful garden setting. Price: \$75.00 / per night, double occupancy, extra persons \$10.00 each breakfast included.

The Bamboo house: A charming studio cottage with lots of screened windows. The cottage feels open, airy and bright. It has a separate, external stone bathroom in a garden setting (not an “outhouse” but it is a short walk down a private pathway). Features a full size bed, sitting area with sleeper sofa, dining area, and great views of the sacred mountain Mandango and the Vilcabamba valley. Price: \$50.00 / per night, double occupancy, one extra person \$10.00, breakfast included.

Area hotels and hostals

Hotel Madre Tierra: This is the closest hotel to the conference. It is easily within walking distance (as long as you don't mind a steep hill climb!) Beautiful rooms, nice garden setting, and a great restaurant.

Transportation:

Airlines: Check out www.sidestep.com or www.expedia.com or do a key word search for airlines servicing **Quito, Ecuador** (UIO). The cheapest departure points in the United States tend to be Miami (MIA), Los Angeles (LAX), and Houston (IAH).

From Quito, Ecuador you will fly **TAME Airlines to Loja**, Ecuador.

Private taxi: We would be happy to send a driver to pick you up at the airport and deliver you directly to your lodging in Vilcabamba. The cost for this would be \$30.00

TIP: Flights don't always go exactly as planned...not in Ecuador, nor anywhere else. Be sure to leave enough time between arriving in Quito and leaving on Tame for Loja to account for the unexpected.
